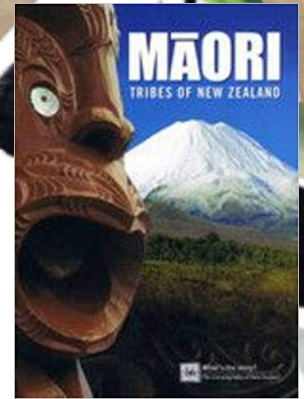


### Maori Tribes of New Zealand

### Wild Journeys

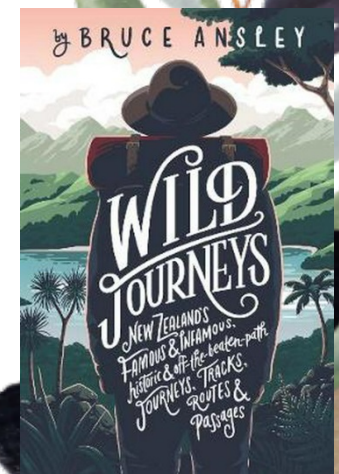

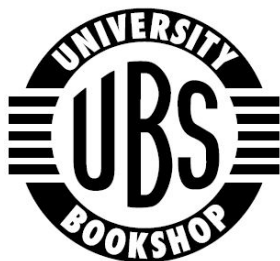
